

The proper way to fill out *Rod Roy skier progress report*:

Write legibly (neat & tidy, not in pencil) Please take the time to fill them out. Pay attention to what you are writing and take into consideration how you would feel if you were to receive your evaluation card.

FRONT SIDE: The card will have the **student's name label** on it.

DO NOT CHECK OFF A COLOUR LEVEL: The Skier colour levels will be verified and checked off at the office based on supervisor evaluations.

BACK SIDE: Check boxes: **check off the boxes that correspond to their abilities.**



Comments: **Write a positive point** (example: *Great job working on parallel turns*). **Something for them to work on.** (Example: *Remember to control your speed by completing your turns, especially on steeper terrain*) **Some sort of salutation** (example: *Keep on smiling! Great attitude!*)

You can embellish the report cards with small stickers or simple drawings if you wish.

Report cards need to be submitted with the internal evaluation sheet for your class. Complete the skier description codes for **each student** indicating the type of trails they are best suited for (green, blue or black) and if they are aggressive or cautious. These descriptions help place students in appropriate classes for next season.
